Learner's Permit Instructions:

All students must go to Department of Public Safety to get the learning permit. To avoid the lengthy lines, Champion recommends scheduling an appointment 60 days before the student turns 15 and a half. Look below for step-by-step instructions on how to navigate the DPS website. Keep in mind the earliest a student is eligible for the permit is 15 and a half years old.
